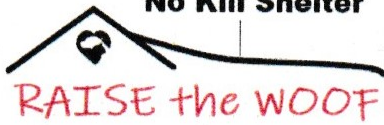

Is my donation tax-deductible?

For certain filers, the donation is tax deductible. Consult your tax advisor for options. The MCHS is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization.

Why do you need a new building?

The MCHS, located in White Rock on land donated by homeless pet advocate pioneer Flossy Fleming, is operating out of the original 1978 block building, and the facility is woefully out of date. Renovation efforts over the years have kept the Shelter going, but now many areas of the current building are no longer safe for staff and animals.

How long has the Shelter been in operation?

The MCHS was incorporated in 1945 and has been helping homeless animals find their forever homes for more than 75 years!

Where will the new shelter be located?

The MCHS and several partners, including the Marion County Commission and the Marion County Regional Development Corporation, researched options to determine the best location to meet current and future needs. After looking at several properties and options, we determined that remaining on the original property in White Rock is the most cost-effective option.

How many cats and dogs will the new shelter house?

The new shelter will provide 30 indoor/outdoor runs for dogs and three rooms with porches for cats. Cats will have a combination of free-roam rooms and cages for litters and space for cats recuperating after illness. Additionally, the new shelter will have a whelping room for canine litters, rooms for new intakes, and isolation rooms for sick felines and canines.

How is the new shelter being financed?

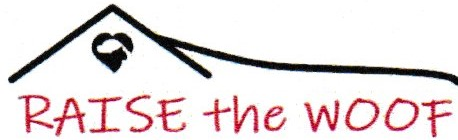
Through the generous donations of several Marion County residents who left monies in their estates to the MCHS, we were able to set up a new shelter fund. This fund allowed us to qualify for a construction loan to be financed by Monongahela Valley Bank.

Will the Shelter remain open during construction?

The current shelter building will be demolished, but we will remain in operation with limited services. In addition to working with area shelters, fosters, and rescues, we have a temporary location at 864 Husky Highway (formerly Pet Central Veterinary Clinic) in Fairmont.

When is the New Shelter expected to open?

The target date for completion is late Fall of 2022.
